NOT A JOKE – MONEY

A corporate attorney sent the following advice to the employees in his company. Next time you order cheques, have only your initials and last name on them, not your first name. If someone takes your cheque book they will not know whether you sign your full name or just your initials, but the bank will know. Do not sign the back of your credit cards instead put photo id required.

When you are writing cheques to pay on your credit card account do not put the full account number, on the “for” line just the last four digits. The credit card company knows the full number, but no one handling your cheque will.

Place the contents of your wallet on a photocopier. Do both sides of each licence, credit card etc. you will then know what you had in your wallet and all the account numbers and phone numbers to call and cancel. Keep the photocopies in a safe place. If your wallet or credit card is stolen there are a few things you should know. Keep all the toll free numbers you need to cancel your cards where you can find them.

File a police report immediately in the jurisdiction where your wallet was stolen. This proves to credit providers that you were diligent, and is a help towards any future investigation.

Call the three national credit reporting organisations immediately to place a fraud alert on your name and social security number. This will stop any attempt at identity theft, and will stop the use of the cards involved. As calls for credit checks will raise an alert.

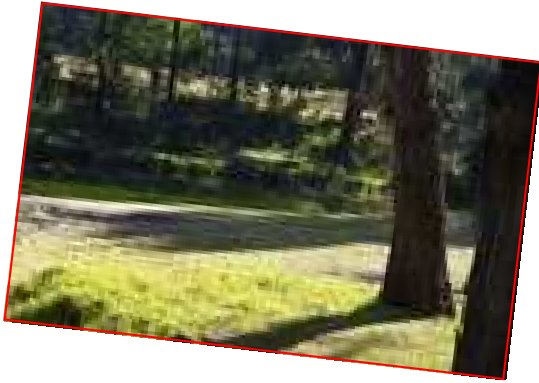

Ride Etiquette

Ride Leaders

1. Before leaving, advise riders of the destination and where designated stops are to be.
2. Be aware that you are leading a convoy of many bikes and stay in one lane as much as possible.
3. Minimise lane changes
4. When at rest stops, give 10 minutes notice of leaving to riders.

Riders

1. Keep at least 2 bikes in view of your mirrors
2. Notify tail end Charlie if you are leaving the ride
3. NO overtaking on corners/ bends
4. Bikes to be fully fuelled before start of ride
5. Remember – Always ride safety and within the law

Ride Leaders are advised to restrict their pre-ride instructions to the job specification

i.e. timings, directions, distance, coffee or lunch stops etc. Any further advice would be outside the limit of a ride leader's authority and should not include advising members on how they should ride their bikes.

There is a statutory requirement that each rider be licensed to operate a motorcycle and do so in accordance with the rules of the road and in a safe manner. This would imply that a rider must rely on his/her own abilities and senses, under all conditions and not rely on the comments and judgement of others, such as a ride leader.
